This trip is the perfect way to get perspective on the grandeur of Yosemite and to round out your connection to this amazing national park.

2-7 participants. Reservations recommended. Contact Recreation Desk for availability and pricing for groups of 8 or more.

## DIFFICULTY/AGE LIMIT

Participants should be comfortable hiking up to 5.5 miles on flat to steep terrain at altitudes between 8,600 and 10,850 feet. The trip is suitable for fit individuals ages 12 and above.

## MEETING PLACE

All trips meet at the Recreation Desk 15 minutes before departure.

## WHAT TO BRING

- Completed Trip Registration Forms
- Park admission or your Park pass if you already have one
- Small backpack with minimum 48 oz. water and snacks
- Proper footwear – hiking boots preferred
- Layered clothing including wind/rain jacket (high country weather is unpredictable and can include afternoon thunderstorms and wind)
- Bug repellent, sunscreen, hat and sunglasses
- Camera and binoculars

## OTHER INFORMATION

Our first-aid-certified guides carry first aid kits, permits, maps, radios/cell phones. Guide gratuity not included; for exemplary service a 10-20% tip is customary.
