## Giant Sequoia Guided Snowshoe Walk

*"Do behold the King in his glory, King Sequoia! Behold! Behold!" – John Muir*

A visit to the majestic Giant Sequoias is stunning anytime of the year but winter and spring make for particularly impressive outings. Walking on snowshoes (or on foot if snow is limited) is easy and opens up a landscape that is seen by few visitors. Our three-mile round trip walk along the historic Old Big Flat Road descends through the forest to our destination, a serene and spectacular grove of sequoias. The stunning contrast of white snow against the reddish bark of the sequoias, the largest living species on earth, makes for magnificent photos and memories. These trees are one of the reasons Yosemite was declared a National Park and our experience will give you a greater appreciation of this massive and unique Redwood. In the spring, wildflowers and birds typically join us on our hike, adding to the serenity and beauty. Our guides will share with you knowledge about the Park and the sequoias and will help make sure your experience is fun and inspiring!



**Trip Time:** 9AM-1:30PM

**Group size:** 2-13 participants. Reservations recommended or see the Recreation Desk for availability.

**Meeting Place:** All trips meet in the Recreation Center 15 minutes before departure.

**Price:** \$75 Adults; \$50 Kids 12 and under. Includes transportation, naturalist guide, snowshoe rental and lunch voucher for use in our General Store.

**Difficulty/Age Limit:** Participants should be comfortable walking up to 3 miles on varied terrain at altitudes up to 6,000 feet. There are modest climbs and descents on this snowshoe and it requires a reasonable effort. The trip is suitable for fit individuals ages 8 and above.

### What To Bring:

- Completed Trip Registration Forms
- Park admission or your Park pass if you already have one
- Small backpack with minimum 32 oz. water and snacks
- Proper footwear – waterproof, warm boots with warm socks
- Waterproof wind/rain jacket
- Other warm clothing including thermal top and bottom, warm ski hat and gloves
- Camera and binoculars (optional)



**Other Information:** Our guides carry first aid kits, permits, maps, radios/cell phones and water filters. Guide gratuity is not included in your trip price; for exemplary service, a 10-20% tip is encouraged.
