You'll enjoy the rich sights and sounds of the forest, and you might even make a new friend in your trusty four-legged companion. Choose from 1 or 2-hour riding adventures throughout the day, including a breakfast ride, sunset rides, a Steak Ride, and a Campfire and Wagon Ride.

Tours leave on the hour every hour starting at 8am from the Camp Mather Stables just 1 mile down the road from the Evergreen. Mather's Wranglers are also available for private rides.



TRIP TIME

1 & 2 Hour Rides: leave every hour on the hour starting at 8am, last departure 3pm

2 Hour Breakfast Ride: 8am (24-hour notice)

1 Hour Sunset Ride: 5pm. 2 Hour Sunset Ride: 4pm

2 Hour Steak Ride: 5pm (24-hour notice)

1 Hour Campfire and Wagon Ride: 7pm (24-hour notice)
