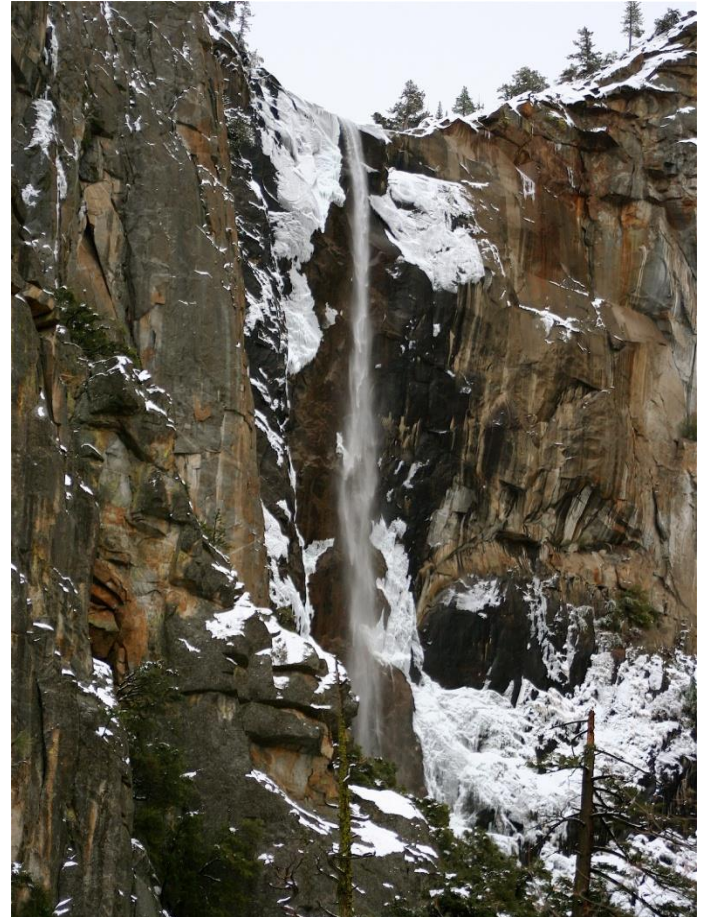

#### **‘Range of Light’ Yosemite Valley Naturalist Tour**

#### **Giant Sequoia Guided Hike or Snowshoe**

Experience the beauty of a snow-covered Yosemite and the majesty of the Giant Sequoias on this 3-mile round-trip hike or snowshoe adventure. The stunning contrast of white snow against the reddish bark of the sequoias, the largest living species on earth, is like nothing you have ever seen. Our guides will share knowledge about the Park and the sequoias, and they will help make sure your experience is fun and inspiring!

#### **‘Wonders of Yosemite’ Naturalist Hike and Tour**
