1	Check/add fuel	Pinch points for fingers, vision damage Skin contact with substances from spills or splashes, inhalation of vapors	Wear gloves and other safety items; avoid pinch points by keeping eyes on task Add gasoline and additives in safe, uncrowded, and well-ventilated area; wear eye protection; clean up small fuel spills (<1 gallon) and medium spills (1 – 5 gallons) immediately; in case of large spills (>5 gallons), contact Management.
2	Start blower	Muscle strain Hearing damage to self and others Dust inhalation by self and others	Pull cord straight back from blower in one smooth motion; check line of fire of arm and elbow for obstacles. Wear ear plugs Wear dust mask; pause for pedestrians or motorists to move past immediate location
3	Use blower to clean area.	Muscle strain Hearing damage to self and others Dust inhalation by self and others	Use easy, short sweeping motion; avoid twisting and bending. Wear ear plugs Wear dust mask; pause for pedestrians or motorists to move past immediate location
4	Reporting Accidents/Injuries:	None	Immediately report all accidents to Management.
