1	Chopping kindling	Cutting hands, fingers, feet, toes; splinters; pinching fingers; wood chips in eyes	Wear PPE (gloves, eye protection, closed-toed shoes); use proper training and technique; keep fingers away from pinch points
2	Building fire	Splinters; pinching fingers	Wear PPE (gloves); keep fingers away from pinch points
3	Lighting fire	Burning skin or clothes	Maintain proper distance from fire; use appropriate fireplace tools
4	Stoking fire	Burning skin or clothes; flaming logs rolling out of fireplace	Maintain proper distance from fire; use appropriate fireplace tools; be aware of fire construction and adjust logs carefully
5	Reporting Accidents/Injuries:	None	Immediately report all accidents to Management.
